

CITY OF SURREY
BYLAW NO. 18582

A bylaw to amend the provisions of "Surrey Dog
Responsibility By-law, 1999, No. 13880", as amended.

The Council of the City of Surrey ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. "Surrey Dog Responsibility By-law, 1999, No. 13880", as amended is hereby further amended as follows:

a. Section 8 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with a new Section 8 as follows:

"8. Every application for a license must be accompanied by a license fee payable as follows:

for each male dog	\$ 67.50
for each neutered male dog	\$ 41.50
for each female dog	\$ 67.50
for each spayed female dog	\$ 41.50
for each potentially dangerous dog	\$ 127.00
for each dangerous dog	\$268.00

Before issuing a license for a spayed female dog or a neutered male dog the License Inspector may require the owner to furnish proof that the dog has been spayed or neutered."

b. Section 28 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with a new Section 28 as follows:

"28. The owner, possessor or harbourer of an unlicensed dog impounded pursuant to the provisions of the By-law may reclaim the dog on application to the Poundkeeper at any time prior to its sale or destruction on proof of ownership and on payment of the prescribed license fee together with the sum of \$104.00 plus the cost to the Poundkeeper of having a microchip or tattoo placed on the dog, or the sum of \$208.00."

c. Section 29 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with a new Section 29 as follows:

"29. The owner, possessor or harbourer of a dog which is not an unlicensed dog or a dangerous dog impounded pursuant to the provisions of this By-law may reclaim the dog on application to the Pound keeper at any time prior to its sale or destruction on proof of ownership and on payment of the following charges:

- (a) for the first impounding of the dog, the sum of \$31.00 plus the cost to the Pound keeper of having a microchip or tattoo placed on the dog, or the sum of \$104.00;
- (b) for the second impounding of the dog, the sum of \$78.00;
- (c) for the third impounding of the dog, the sum of \$208.00;
- (d) for the fourth impounding of the dog and any subsequent impounding of the dog, the sum of \$520.00;
- (e) if the dog has not been impounded within the previous 24 month period, the impound fee will be reset to the amount stated in clause (a)."

d. Section 34 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with a new Section 34 as follows:

"34. If a dangerous dog is unlicensed at the time of impoundment then the license fee for the current year will be \$268.00 and will be payable in addition to the impound fee, and a license subsequently issued."

e. Section 38 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with a new Section 38 as follows:

"38. In addition to the impound fees payable under this By-law, the owner, possessor or harbourer of a dog impounded pursuant to the provisions of this By-law must also pay a maintenance fee of \$15.50 for each day the dog has remained in the Pound upon reclamation of the dog."

2. This Bylaw shall be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Dog Responsibility Bylaw, 1999, No. 13880, Amendment Bylaw, 2015, No. 18582".
