

CITY OF SURREY  
BY-LAW NO. 18599

A bylaw to amend the provisions of "Surrey Animal  
Compensation By-law, 1982, No. 7065", as amended.

The Council of the City of Surrey ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. "Surrey Animal Compensation By-law, 1982, No. 7065", as amended is hereby further amended as follows:

- 1) Section 4 is removed in its entirety and replaced with a new Section 4 as follows:

The payment pursuant to any claim under this Bylaw shall be in accordance with the following schedule:

Chickens	\$1.55 each	Maximum Allowed Per Claim	\$52.00
Turkeys	\$5.25 each	Maximum Allowed Per Claim	\$104.00
Bantams	\$1.05 each	Maximum Allowed Per Claim	\$26.00
Ducks	\$2.60 each	Maximum Allowed Per Claim	\$78.00
Geese	\$5.25 each	Maximum Allowed Per Claim	\$104.00
Goats	\$52.00 each	Maximum Allowed Per Claim	\$208.00
Kids	\$26.00 each	Maximum Allowed Per Claim	\$104.00
Sheep	\$88.00 each	Maximum Allowed Per Claim	\$441.50
Lambs:			
(Up to 2 months)	\$26.00 each	Maximum Allowed Per Claim	\$130.00
(Over 2, Up to 4 months)	\$52.00 each	Maximum Allowed Per Claim	\$260.00
(Over 4, Up to 6 months)	\$78.00 each	Maximum Allowed Per Claim	\$390.00
Rabbits	\$2.10 each	Maximum Allowed Per Claim	\$52.00

2. This Bylaw shall be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Animal Compensation Bylaw, 1982, No. 7065, Amendment Bylaw, 2015, No. 18599".
