**SUBJECT: Cloverdale Youth Park**

## **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that Council:

1. Receive this information.
2. Approve the proposed Cloverdale Youth Park location on 64th Avenue, as more fully described in this report.

## **BACKGROUND**

On May 10, 1999 Council received a delegation which recommended a site on 176th Street for the new Cloverdale Youth Park. Following the delegation, Council requested that staff carry out a further review of potential sites on which the Youth Park could be located.

## **DISCUSSION**

The subsequent review process involved representatives of the Cloverdale Community, the Cloverdale Rodeo and Exhibition Association, the Cloverdale Horseshoe Pitching Club, the Cloverdale RCMP and Cloverdale youth. Based on input received in the review process, the preferred location was identified as being west of the Horseshoe Pitch on the north side of the Cloverdale Fairgrounds near 64th Avenue (see Location Map, Appendix 1).

On July 20, 1999 a public open house was held at the Cloverdale Recreation Centre to present the preferred location for the Cloverdale Youth Park. The open house was well attended and many positive comments were received. The choice was unanimous in support of the preferred location as identified above.

## **CONCLUSION**

This proposed site is appropriate for the development of a youth park, as it offers good access, good sight lines and is located in the heart of the Cloverdale Community on a bus route.
