

SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

The proposed works support the City's Sustainability Charter in relation to the following goals:

- EC2: Economic Development Strategy and an Employment Land Strategy – by providing expanded communications capacity and coverage in the City to serve businesses and residents.
- EN8: Sustainable Engineering Standards and Practices – by minimizing environmental impacts during construction.

CONCLUSION

Based on the above discussion, it is recommended that Council authorize the appropriate City officials to execute a license agreement with Rogers that will act to grant Rogers a non-exclusive right to install, operate and maintain telecommunications infrastructure for a 10-year period within the road allowance at the northwest corner of Highway 10 (56 Avenue) and 148 Street in Surrey as illustrated in Appendix I attached to this report.
