The Council met at the Town Hall on the 25th Feb at 1 o'clock P.M., Members present the Reeve and Councillors, Stewart, Shannon and Armstrong. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted. ~~Moved by Coun Stewart~~ ~~sec by Coun Shannon~~ that the minutes of the previous meeting be adopted as read ~~carried~~, Moved by Coun Armstrong sec by Coun Shannon that the following changes be recommended in the Municipal Act, Road tax, to have the Government fix the rate, To have five Councillors and a Reeve, Nomination and Election on the one day, Respecting wild land tax, that the following words be added after the word, rise, in sec 122, "In addition to all other taxes", ~~and~~ That Councillors be paid, And that Statute labor be levied on the assessed value of all real estate, and Statute ~~as for~~ labor as provided for at present be abolished, carried.

Moved by ^{Coun} Armstrong sec by Coun Shannon that the Clerk obtain a list of the rates of printing from each of the local printing offices, and present them at the next meeting of the Council, so that the Council can be ~~be~~ guided thereby, carried.

The Reeve was instructed to make arrangements for the surrender of the Letters Patent, at as early a date as possible.
