

Municipal Hall Survey Jan 21<sup>st</sup> 1884

Council met according to statute, all members having subscribed the oath of office, the Reeve in the chair.

Minutes of last meeting read and confirmed  
Communication received from the Chilkwhack Council

On motion communication ordered filed  
Coun McDougall gave notice, that at the next meeting he would introduce a Bylaw to amend the rules of order  
The clerk reported he had endeavored to get the Municipal Hall site, writings or deed matter arranged, but that Mr. Sole the crewick legal adviser to the Council, who held said deed was absent from the province

That the appropriation made by the Council at its session Sep 6<sup>th</sup> 1884, toward assisting the settlers on the Kensington Prairie in opening a road on the Coast Meridian, south from the Picamble River, be expended, according to terms there set forth; in clearing the said line to the width of thirty feet (18 feet on centre line to be cut level with ground or grubbed) from the Picamble River south to the N W corner sec 19 T<sup>h</sup> 7 Carried

That applications be received for the position of Clerk  
Assessor & Collector, for the Municipality, for the current year  
applications to be in at next meeting Carried

Moved by Com Bootroyd sec by Com Shannon  
That the remuneration for the several offices be \$175 for present year

Moved in amendment by Com McDougall sec by Com Brown  
That the remuneration for the several offices be \$150 for present year

The amendment on being put was defeated

The original motion was then put and Carried

That there be \$50<sup>00</sup> appropriated for repairs necessary to  
bridge on Browns Road, Gledbs Prairie The Clerk to draw  
specifications for same, and call for tenders, said tenders to be in  
at the next meeting of the Council, the money to be paid when  
collected Carried

Moved by Com Bootroyd sec by Com Brown  
That the Clerk be paid balance of salary, due for 1883  
Carried

Moved by Com McDougall sec by Com Johnston

That the Council do now adjourn to meet again on  
Saturday Feb 2<sup>nd</sup> 1884 at 1 o'clock P.M. Carried
