Council met pursuant to adjournment present the Revue and all the councillors, the minutes of previous meeting read and confirmed Resolutions were received from Mr. M. R. Barry requesting permission to perform his 1893 statute labor, not granted

Maggie McInnis asking permission to have her statute labor performed on Hirth road permission granted

Mr. Wm Corbett complaining that he could not get enough gravel on the Road limit to complete his Contract, he was authorized to go beyond the road limit for gravel to complete the work.

Mr. E. J. Knight asking to be allowed a refund of an amount of \$5²⁰ he claimed he had paid on land not owned by him (for taxes in 1892), request not granted

Mr. J. A. Forin (Re Medham) advising that the Court had ordered, the amt. of Mr. Medham's account \$298²/₁₀₀ to be paid at once into the Court. amount was paid through Mr. Forin to the court,

the clerk was authorized to get some blank receipt books and stationery

complaint was made to the Council that the railroad ditch southeast of the Niornette river being without a flood gate, that the tide flowed in and was damaging the settlers. Clerk was authorized to write the Company in regard to this matter

Complaint was also made that there was no Railway crossing on the North Bluff road 3/4 mile west of Halls Prairie Road, and 2 miles north of Douglass. Clerk to request them to put in same at once

A petition signed by Mr. Geo. Wales and 3 others asking for a portion of the \$100 granted to the C.V.R. be given them to assist in opening the "Slough" ~~connecting~~ into the serpentine River. request not granted as grant is to improve the road.

Coun. Johnson reported having let a piece of work of clearing and turnpiking on the Campbell river Road east of Halls Prairie to Mr Jas Cutchley for \$50 received
