Pursuant to the provisions of the "Local Improvement Act", "Highway Water Works Local Improvement Proceedings By-law 1941 No 670" and amending By-law No. 689, and to resolution of the Council passed on the 18th day of May, 1942, the Court of Revision of the Special Assessment Roll prepared in accordance with said Act, By-laws and resolution met and sat at 10 a.m.

Present. Reeve J. J. Brown, presiding by appointment of the Court.

Mr. John G. Yanner was appointed Secretary of the Court and, as Municipal Clerk took from the members present the oath prescribed by Section 239 of the "Municipal Act".

The following appeals were presented to the Court in writing, no person appearing before the Court, namely -

R. Kisby, - portion of Section 35, Block 5 N, Range 2 W, Sketch 5983
 (except part - Sketch 7479)
 Complaint that the assessed frontage is in excess of actual frontage of property

Douglas P. Robertson and Kate Robertson, - E 1/2 Block 5, Section 35,
 Block 5 N, Range 2 W, Map 3352 -
 Complaint that the assessed frontage of 202.95 should be reduced to actual frontage of 194.5 feet.

H. Markham, - West part of Block 6, Section 35, Block 5 N, Range 2
 West, ^{Sketch} Map 8343.
 Complaint that in view of the fact that his property is of triangular shape and is for 500 feet at a depth of 10 feet below road level, the assessed frontage should be reduced.

The following appeals, received after legal date were also presented, namely; -

John Hale Woolliams and Alice Bertha Woolliams - East part of Block 6, Section 35, Block 5 N, Range 2 W, Map 3352 -
 Complaint that owing to the conformation of his property in relation to Bear Creek, the assessed frontage should be reduced.

David B. Brantlin, Block 1, Section 34, Block 5 N, Range 2 W, ^{Map 880}
 Complaint that scheme is too costly and unnecessary and

that the main will not run past his property.
