

Municipal Hall, Surrey Centre B.C.
July 7th 1890

Council met pursuant to adjournment Members present
Couns McCallum, Douglas, Armstrong, Povey & Brown, as McReay
was not present. The Clerk agreeably to the provisions of the bylaw
for the regulation of the proceedings of the Council, called
upon the Councillors present, to elect, from among themselves
one to act as chairman in the absence of the Reeve, where on
motion Coun Armstrong was elected chairman

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and on
motion approved

Communications were received from A. A. Anderson
re a draw in the C. P. Road Bridge and in the Govt's Ferguson
bridge on the Nicomekl River. Received & placed on file, clerk to reply.

W. S. Clay re the proposed increase in the amount to be charged
for retail liquor licenses, received & placed on file, clerk to reply.

G. P. Dufor re the very bad state of the C. M. Road north of Southways
and H. B. Boyes re the condition of the McKeenan road east of G. P. Road,
C. A. Cormier & others, praying that the Kensington Prairie road
east from Kensington School House to the Grove Valley road be opened
and offering a sum of money aggregating \$ toward its
construction. Referred to Couns McCallum and Povey respectively
for action thereon.

E. J. Munro re the assessed value on town lots on the Blaine B.C.
townsite and requesting that an abatement be made, received
and placed on file, clerk to reply.

That the collector be instructed to deposit all monies collected by
him on behalf of the Corporation, in the Bank of B.C. to the
credit of the Corporation of Surrey, and that he produce a dup-
licate deposit slip for each deposit so made

Carried

On motion by Coun Brown sec by Coun Parr
That Coun McCallum be authorized to sign cheques on the
Corporation during the absence of the Reeve

Carried

On motion by Coun Brown sec by Coun McCallum
That Mr W. McBride be allowed \$100 on the work in progress, on the dyke
around his property and that the same be charged to the ac of the
Drainage and dyking scheme.

Carried

Mr Ferguson handed in a communication, drawing the atten-
tion of the Council to the danger likely to ensue, from the neglect
to destroy the noxious weeds growing on the road sides.

The clerk was instructed verbally to interview Mr. McRae re his
ape against the Council for a suit of clothes furnished to one Peel
on the order of Dr. M. McLean, and endeavor to compromise the matter
paying the amount that may be agreed upon, and taking Mr. McRae's receipt
therefore.

On motion by Coun McCallum sec by Coun Douglas
That the clerk be paid \$100⁰⁰ on ac of salary for the

current year

Coun McCallum gave notice, that at next meeting of the Council, he will introduce a bylaw to prevent the spread of noxious weeds. Carried
