Minutes of a Special Open Meeting  
held in the Council Chamber Thursday,  
July 9, 1970 at 5:35 p.m.

Those present: Acting Mayor Kuhn  
Aldermen Dunster, Jones, Johnston,  
and Patterson and Mayor Vander Zalm.  
Also present were the Manager and  
Clerk.

The Special Meeting had been called by Acting Mayor  
Kuhn to discuss the re-opening of the Elgin disposal grounds.

Acting Mayor Kuhn stated that he had received a great number  
of calls from residents of South Surrey that they now had  
no place to dispose of their garbage and there is no  
Municipal collection service in the area. Many are elderly  
people that are not able to drive to the Port Mann site,  
others have no transportation at all to get to this location  
with garbage for disposal.

He stated the Engineer will report on the matter of garbage  
collection in this area within two weeks. If the area is  
approved by the property owners it is hoped to have a collection  
service within two months.

He also requested Council to reconsider the matter of  
providing a disposal area for the South Surrey residents.

Moved by Mayor Vander Zalm

Seconded by Alderman Jones

That the Elgin disposal grounds be  
re-opened by placing a truck at the entrance to the grounds  
where garbage can be placed and trucked to the Port Mann site  
with it to be in effect as soon as possible.

Carried unanimously

Alderman Dunster stated that he had voted in favour of the  
motion, but did not wish that this be considered a precedent  
for the Municipality.

Seconded by Alderman Patterson


