The Council met pursuant to adjournment.
Councillors Ardiel and Shepherd were absent.

Moved by Councillor Keery
Seconded by Councillor Graham
That the minutes of the previous meeting be adopted as read.
Carried.

DELEGATIONS:

Messrs. Currie, Christmas and Greenaway, representing the Lower Fraser Valley Agricultural Association came before the Council and requested assistance in clearing and grading a portion of the lands recently acquired by the Association for extension of the race track.

Councillor Ardiel took his seat at this point in the meeting.

Mr. Currie, acting as spokesman for the delegation, gave an outline of the aims of the Agricultural association in connection with further development of these grounds. A general discussion ensued. Mr. Christmas pointed out the advantages which would accrue to the Municipality in developing the fair to Class "B" standards and also the necessity of providing increased accommodation in this connection.

Moved by Councillor Ardiel
Seconded by Councillor Rutledge
That the Reeve, Councillors Rutledge and Keery and the Engineer be appointed a committee to investigate this request and that the committee be empowered to take any action deemed necessary.

A large delegation, representing the Hilltop Business Mens' Association of White Rock came before the Council, drew attention to condition of the Johnston Road and demanded immediate action to remedy this condition.

A lengthy discussion ensued during which the Engineer produced estimates of the costs of repairing the hard surfaced roads throughout the Municipality which had suffered frost damage during the past winter.

Councillor Shepherd took his seat at this point in the meeting.

The Engineer reported that it would require the sum of \$6000.00 to restore the condition of the two mile section of Johnston Road referred to.

The ward appropriations for Public Works was the subject of some discussion and it was suggested that an effort be made to obtain some assistance from the Provincial Government.

Moved by Councillor Ardiel
Seconded by Councillor Shepherd
That the Reeve, Councillors Graham and Keery and the Engineer be appointed a committee to investigate the conditions complained of with power to act.

Messrs. Traaseth and Martin - came before the Council in connection with the petition requesting extension of Grace Road.

Mr. Traaseth spoke on behalf of the delegation and drew attention to flooding conditions on his property and also to the necessity of providing adequate road access to his and adjoining properties.
