June 28 1884

Council met pursuant to adjournment - present - com. Morton  
 Johnson, Shannon, Stewart & Brown. The roll being about  
 com. Brown moved rec. by com. Morton that com. Shannon  
 take the chair. Carried. Minutes of previous meeting  
 read and approved. The bill of T.R. Pearson & Co. <sup>amounting to \$2.50</sup> was presented  
 and moved by com. Brown rec. by com. Stewart - that the bill  
 be paid, Carried. A petition from the settlers on the Falls  
 Prairie Road was read asking for an appropriation of  
 \$100<sup>00</sup> on that road; they agreeing to subscribe \$40<sup>00</sup>  
 Moved by com. Brown rec. by com. Stewart - that \$40<sup>00</sup> be  
 allowed to ditch the road from J. Fitzmaurice corner to the prairie  
 a distance of 92 rods. Carried. <sup>Have com. take the chair & business proposed</sup> The tenders for the  
 different roads throughout the Municipality were then opened  
 and the following jobs awarded
