7 March 15th 1884

Council met pursuant to adjournment

Present Councillors McKeough, Shannon, Johnston & Brown. The Reeve being absent it was moved by Councillor McKeough sec. by Councillor Johnston that Councillor Shannon act as chairman of the Council until another Reeve be elected. viz. Hillier having resigned. ^{carried}

Minutes of previous meeting read and adopted.

Communications were read from John R. Hall, secretary to Sir John A. McDonald, from H. T. Thrift, John Oliver, William Shannon, Geo. W. Carr & others, Arthur Hillier and Geo. Bortroyd. Moved by Councillor McKeough sec. by Councillor Johnston that Geo. Oliver be paid \$200⁰⁰ on account of contract for gravelling Sunnyside Road and that he be allowed an extension of time of two months in which to complete his contract - provided he remain his bond. ^{carried}

The bill for advertising the Intelligence office in the "British Columbian" for 1 1/2 months was presented and Councillor McKeough moved, sec. by Councillor Johnston that the said bill of \$5.25 be paid. ^{carried}

Moved by Councillor McKeough sec. by Councillor Johnston that Councillors Brown & Shannon be appointed to inspect

the work on the Falls Prairie Road and to give an
order for the amount they see proper on account of ^{an} Contract.
Moved by Com. McKeungall sec. by Com. Johnston that
the resignation of the Reeve and Com. Bothroyd be accepted.
The tenders, three in number, for repairs on Shannon
Hill Falls Prairie Road were here opened and were
as follows; Alexander McKenzie \$161.⁰⁰ Jacob Jakman
\$144.⁰⁰ + A. A. Hart \$119.⁰⁰. Moved by Com. Brown sec. by
Com. Johnston that the contract be let to the lowest
bidder. Carried. Moved by Com. McKeungall sec. by
Com. Brown that the communications received from John
R. Hall, respecting the cemetery, - H. T. Thrift - and the commu-
-nication respecting the opening up of the Carr's Road
through to the Yale road ~~be~~ be placed on file. Carried.
Moved by Com. Brown sec. by Com. Johnston that
Coms. Shannon & Brown be appointed to inspect the
bridge on Brown's Road Falls Prairie. Carried.
Moved by Com. McKeungall sec. by Com. Johnston
that John Woodward be paid the sum of \$2.⁰⁰ for
clearing the timber out of the Clellan & Kirkland Roads.
Moved by Com. McKeungall sec. by Com. Johnston that
the clerk request - Mr. H. T. Thrift - to deliver to him the ballot-
box used at the last election. Carried.

Moved by com. McElroyall sec by com. Brown that - an election for Revere and councillor for ward No 1 be held and and that - the nomination be held on March 24th and that - B.B. Smith act - as returning officer at - said election, carried -
Moved by com. McElroyall sec, by com. Brown that - the Council now adjourn to meet again on the 29 of March at One o'clock P.M.
