The Council met pursuant to adjournment.
Councillors Shepherd and Graham were absent.

Moved by Councillor Rutledge
Seconded by Councillor Ardiel
That the Minutes of the meeting of March 3rd be adopted as

read.

Messrs. Vogan and Fox - representing the North Surrey Volunteer Fire Brigade came before the Council and requested that the former A.R.P. Bickle Pump stationed at Port Kells be officially turned over to this department. They undertook to maintain the equipment in serviceable condition.

It was pointed out that if the equipment were attached to the North Surrey Fire Area, it would still have to be available for use in any part of the Municipality when required.

The delegation agreed that this arrangement would be satisfactory.

Decision on this matter was deferred until later in the meeting.

Mrs. Christmas and Mr. Brooker, President and Treasurer of the Surrey Branch of the Victorian Order of Nurses - waited on the Council and requested a grant of \$2,500.00 to carry on their work in the District for the current year. A copy of their budget for the current year was produced showing estimated receipts of \$6,930.00 and estimated expenditure of \$10,484.00.

It was pointed out that the sum of \$800.00 was still owing by the Municipality on account of the grant authorized in 1946 and the Reeve enquired if the amount now requested, included this \$800.00. The delegation undertook to obtain this information and to appear later in the meeting.

Mr. James Scroggie - came before the Council and requested approval of a plan of subdivision of portion of Lot 27, Section 16, Block 5N, Range 2W, Map 493, which had been refused by the Approving Officer because of his refusal to dedicate the North 33 feet of this lot for road purposes.

The matter was discussed to some length.

Seconded by Councillor Rutledge

That the Council endorse the stand taken by the Approving Officer and refuse to give approval to the proposed plan of subdivision until the necessary requirements for road access had been met.

Mr. Sowden - came before the Council and requested that the bridge over the ditch at the crossing over the B. C. Electric Railway Co. Limited right of way between Coast Meridian and Roebuck Roads be replaced in order to give him access to his property.

This matter was discussed and was referred to Councillor Keery and the Engineer for investigation and report.

Messrs. Eade and Elliott - representing the Board of Park Commissioners waited on the Council and the current estimates of the Board were gone into in considerable detail.
