Council met pursuant to adjournment all members present. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved. Communications were read from the following localities asking for appropriations for their several districts - from settlers on the coast-Meridian asking for ~~150~~ ^{\$300} from settlers on the Kensington Prairie asking for ~~150~~ ^{\$} also the petition of Geo. W. Cann & others was taken off file Moved by coun. Shannon sec. by coun. Johnston that the communication from the settlers on the Coast-Meridian be laid over till next meeting. Carried.

Moved by Coun. Horton sec by coun. Johnston, that the communications from the settlers on Kensington Prairie and the petition from Geo W. Cann & others be laid over until after the Court of Revision, Carried.

Moved by Coun Horton sec by coun Brown that the council resolve itself into committee of the whole to consider the steam ferry bylaw by clause, Carried.

Coun Horton took the chair and after passing clause after ^{clause} 10 the chairman reported the bylaw favorably to the resolve, Moved by Coun Stewart - sec by Coun. Brown that the steam ferry bylaw pass its second reading as received from committee of the whole Carried.

Moved by com Brown sec by com Stewart - that - the steam
jury bylaw be read a third time, Carried. After reading ^{the} preamble
Moved by com Stewart - sec. by com Brown that - the steam
jury bylaw pass its third reading, Carried.

Moved by com Brown sec by com Shannon that - the
clerk be authorized to go over to Simmahmo and collect the
back taxes due on the Hurms land, Carried.

now adjourn to meet again on the 14th of June at 10 A.M. ^{Carried}
