

Municipal Hall
May 3rd 1884

Council met pursuant to adjournment; present - couns.
Brown, Stewart, Shannon, Johnston & Horton,
Moved by coun. Brown sec. by coun. Stewart - that -
coun. Shannon take the chair in the absence of Ruwe
McElroy. Carried.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.
Communications ^{read} from Mr. J. T. Thrift - regarding Contract
of Halls Prairie Road and requesting to be allowed to
address the council. Moved by coun. Horton sec. by
councilor Stewart - that - he be allowed to address the
Council in respect - to the job on the Halls Prairie Road
for a ^{period} length of five minutes, carried.

Mr. Thrift made a few remarks during which time Ruwe
McElroy coming in took the chair. The communication
from Ganghys laid over from last week, was then taken
up when it was moved by coun. Horton sec. by coun.
Johnston that - it be placed on file, Carried.

The Steam ferry bylaw was here taken up and read.
Moved by coun. Stewart sec. by coun. Brown that - the
steam ferry bylaw pass its first-reading, carried.
Moved by coun. Brown sec. by coun. Stewart - that -

the Council resolve itself into a committee of the whole to ^{carry} consider the steam ferry bylaw with com. Horton in the chair
After section 10 was passed the committee rose and asked leave to sit again, granted.

Moved by com. Brown sec by com. Stewart - that the bylaw for the return and revision of the assessment-roll be reconsidered carried. The assessment-roll bylaw was ^{then} read after which com. Brown moved sec by com. Stewart - that the bylaw for the return and revision of the assessment-roll be finally adopted. Carried.

Moved by com. Horton sec by com. Johnston that the petition in regard to Census Road be taken off file. Carried

Moved by com. Shannon sec by com. Brown that the Council do now adjourn to meet again on the 10th day of May at 1 o'clock P. M.
