Council met pursuant to adjournment; present Revue  
McCloughall presiding and couns Morton, Johnston, Brown  
and Stewart. Minutes of previous meeting read and  
approved. Communications were received from Samuel  
Shannon and from Surveyor A. J. McMillan.

Moved by coun Brown sec. by coun. Stewart - that -  
a committee consisting of couns Stewart, Johnston and  
Morton be appointed to examine Mr Samuel Shannon's  
contract in the Latimer settlement near the Fraser River. <sup>Carried</sup>

Moved by coun Brown sec. by coun Stewart - that - the  
bills of J. C. Atkinson for consultation \$5<sup>00</sup> and A. J. <sup>Carried</sup>  
McMillan for surveying road on Halls Prairie \$23<sup>20</sup> be paid.  
The Revue here stated that - Messrs Smith & Good having  
applied to him he had examined the Ferry slip and  
found it to be finished according to specifications and  
recommended that - it be accepted. Moved by coun Brown  
sec. by coun Johnston that - Messrs Smith & Good be  
paid \$700<sup>00</sup> the contract price of the Ferry slip at -  
Browns Landing. Carried.

Moved by coun Stewart - sec by coun Stewart - sec by  
coun Johnston that \$23<sup>00</sup> be appropriated to repair the

Kirkland & Mc Gillan roads west of the Johnston Road. Carried

Moved by com Stewart - sec. by com Brown that J. Woodward be paid \$3.<sup>85</sup> for work on Simiaknow Road. Carried

Moved by com Morton sec by com Johnston that - Mr Hape be allowed to continue the ditch on the east side of coast Meridian Road in front of his place the same width through to the high land. Carried

Moved by com Brown sec by com Morton that - the Rev be authorized to obtain legal advice respecting Road Tax Receipt No 5 and dated August 13<sup>th</sup> 1884 and if found to be a ~~forgery~~ false to take whatever legal proceedings may be found necessary. Carried

Moved by com Brown sec by com Stewart - that - the Steam Ferry Amendment Bylaw be reconsidered. Carried

Moved by com Morton sec. by com. Brown that - the Steam Ferry Amendment Bylaw be finally passed as reconsidered. Carried

Moved by com Johnston sec by com Morton that com Stewart - ~~and~~ be appointed to let by auction the contract on the Mc Gillan & Kirkland roads on Saturday Nov 22<sup>nd</sup> at 10 A.M.

Moved by com Brown sec by com Stewart - that - the Council do now adjourn to meet again on Saturday December 13<sup>th</sup> 1884 at 1 o'clock P.M. J. G. Morton Chairman
