Communications as follows were read from J. A. Form Eye draft of Tax Sale by law - from J. Bloodland Eye re North Bluff road crossing clerk to reply

J. W. Stein Eye re Thomas Greenham an indigent - laid over for investigation

David Morton Eye re railroad ditch not being capable to carry off surplus water, clerk to reply

The protest against the peddlers and other traders carrying on a transient business in the Municipality was handed in, signed by the merchants and license holders of Surrey -

The report of the Committee, on the line of proposed route to White Rock from the Sunnyside road is that the grade is too steep and recommend that a survey be put on to locate a line with an easier grade, { E. C. Johnson
