As there were not enough of the Councilors present to form a quorum and Mr Reave being absent in the upper country the Councilors present agreed to hold a meeting on Wednesday next Oct 8th at 1 o'clock P.M. for the dispatch of business

Council met pursuant to adjournment, present Councilors Mr Colburn, Douglas Armstrong and Parr

As Mr Reave was not present, the Clerk as provided for in the bylaw for the regulation of the business of the Council, called upon the Gentlemen of the Council who were present to elect one from among themselves to preside at this meeting, when

On motion by Coun Armstrong, sec by Coun Parr that Coun Mr Colburn take the chair

On motion by Coun Armstrong sec by Coun Parr that the Bylaw to provide funds (temporarily) for the completion of the Diking and drainage works be read a last time before the Council and reconsidered

Bylaw read

On motion by Coun Douglas sec by Coun Armstrong that the bylaw, to provide funds (temporarily) for the completion of the Diking and drainage works do pass its final reading before the Council, and that the said bylaw be adopted and that the seal of the Corporation be appended thereto

Carried

In motion by Coun Armstrong sec by Coun Parr  
that in the absence of the Reeve, that Coun Mc Collier  
be authorized to sign with the Clerk the Corporation  
note, to provide funds for the completion of the Diking  
and drainage works, to the amount of \$8000<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub>  
on the Bank of Montreal at two months
