

Town Hall Surrey Centre October 2nd 1909

Council met pursuant to adjournment, the Reeve and all members except Co Sullivan being present. Minutes of previous meeting were read and confirmed; Communications were received as follows:

- From Dr Jones re Camp of the B.C.E. Ry at South Westminster saying the sanitary arrangements are as nearly perfect as is possible for any railroad camp to be, Recd,
- From The Western Municipal News, Recd,
- From R W Hodson Live Stock Commissioner, saying that Major Jav. Shepherd would speak on Road making at Surrey Tuesday Sep 21, and at Cloverdale on Wednesday the 22nd, the meetings to be held in connection with the Surrey Farmers' Institute, Recd,
- From F R Glover asst. Manager B.C.E. Ry, saying the Company will put in a siding at Johnston Road which will be available for the use of the public, Recd,
- From F J. Hart & Co Ltd, thanking the Council for their courtesy in gazetting a road on the Centre line of sec 2 1/2 & 3 from the McDellon Road, north, Recd,
- From H. Bose, Hon sec U. B. C. M., saying the next meeting of the Union would be held in North Vancouver, on Thursday Nov 11th and asking to be advised of the names of representatives, Recd, and the Reeve and Council appointed to attend,
- From Harris & Bull re S. McLeary Estate, Recd, and answered by the Clerk,
- From Thomas Taylor, Minister of Public works, saying the question of graveling the grade on the New Yale Road is now being considered by the Department, and it is hoped that the work can be put in hand in the near future, Recd,
- From Royal City Construction Co submitting price of Concrete Culverts, Recd

- From R. T. Copley asking to have the Johnson Road opened through section 32, B to R, W to afford an outlet for the settlers living thereon, Reid and referred to Co Loucks,
- From A. J. Hill, C. E. enclosing plans of new location of part of the River Road, Reid,
- From W. H. Draper, Engineer, under the Ditches & Water Courses and enclosing Certificate that the Flood Bay for Kensington Prairie Ditch had been completed at a total cost of \$2432.50 and directing the same to be paid, also awarding ~~the~~ the amount to be paid by each party connected with the ditch at \$1740, Reid,
- From J. E. Bird saying Mr Bamford had instructed him to notify the Municipality that any further attempt to divert the little live stream of water crossing his 80 acres from the north will be the basis of an action to restrain the Municipality from such diversion, Reid,

MacNeill re White-Rock Road, saying the Railway Co are prepared to accept the recommendation of the River that the Municipality accept \$700.00 relieving the Company from any further liability, the understanding of course is that this money be expended upon making the repairs which are detailed in the statements seen in, Reid, Moved by Co Keery see by Co Smith that the offer be accepted, carried,
