

Municipal Hall

September 13th 1884

Council met pursuant to adjournment, all members present Rev. Mr. Dargall presiding. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved. Communications were read from Provincial Secretary, ^{from} Thomas Hookway regarding his road, from William Shannon asking an extension of time of one month on Coast Meridian Road, from J. W. Pickard also asking extension of time of six weeks on Clover Valley Road and asking Council to deepen ditch on south side of Nicomechel River Clover Valley Road. The following bills were presented; ~~and ordered~~ ~~paid~~ British Columbia Gazette \$6⁵⁰/₁₀₀ British Columbian \$14.02 and E. Parr work on The Gullan Road \$1.50

Moved by Counc. Brown sec. by Counc. Stewart - that the bills of British Columbia Gazette \$6⁵⁰/₁₀₀ British Columbian \$14.02 and E. Parr \$1⁵⁰/₁₀₀ be paid. Carried. Moved by Counc. Shannon sec. by Counc. Stewart - that - Mr. Wm Shannon & Mr. J. W. Pickard be allowed the extension of time on their Govt contracts asked for in their communication provided they renew their bonds. Carried Mr. A. A. Hart - here stated that - on account of too much water it - was almost - impossible to finish his job on Halls Prairie Road and asked the Council to allow him \$45⁰⁰/₁₀₀ for constructing tail drain from Halls Prairie Road to Campbell River on Stenders Road. Moved by Counc. Brown

me by Coun. Stewart - that - Mr Hart be allowed ^{\$45.00} for
fueling in tail drain from Halls Prairie Road west on Stender Road and
that - he be allowed an extension of time of 10 days on his job on the
Halls Prairie Road Carried.

Moved by Coun. Brown. sec by Coun Stewart - that - the clerk
notify Mr James E. Thom and Dominion Saw Mill Co.
to clear the Campbell River of logs as as to allow the clear
navigation of said stream before the 10th day of October next. Carried

Moved by Coun. Brown sec by Coun Stewart - that - Mr Hart
be paid balance due him on Brown's Road as he has his contract
finished Carried Moved by Coun Brown sec by Coun Johnston
that - A. L. Huck be allowed ^{\$75.00} on his contract on Johnston Carried

Tenders for work on Cairns Road were opened and moved by Coun
Brown sec by Coun Johnston that - the lowest tender be accepted. Carried

The lowest tender being J. W. Douglass who agreed to do the work for
Tender for the ferry slip ~~was~~ ^{was} opened there being but one
that - from Smith and Good. moved by Coun Johnston sec by
Coun Johnston that - the Ferry Wharf tender be accepted. Carried

~~Coun. Harrison~~ Capt - Grant - being present the
Council asked him to say something about the steam
ferry. After showing quite conclusively that the Council
by their bylaw were asking too much he asked them to
strike out the last ~~clause~~ paragraph in clause 8 of the
steam ferry bylaw

Councillor Shannon then gave the following notice

I hereby give notice that - at the next meeting of Council

Com. Shannon.
