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**INFORMATION FOR CONTRACTORS**

The following information is provided to answer questions raised by Contractors for the above named project, to the extent referenced and shall become a part thereof. No consideration will be allowed for extras due to the contractor or any subcontractor not being familiar with this addendum. This Addendum No. 1 contains one (1) page in total:

Q1. Is the daily delivered garbage to the sort area in one single sample or does it come in separate samples from each individual home?

**A1. The delivered waste will come in one single daily sample, not in separate samples from each individual home.**

Q2. The RFQ mentions tonnage and volume of the waste streams. Do the results need to identify the % of organic waste/recyclables etc. as % mass or % volume? Are the previous studies available?

**A2. The City is seeking the percentage of organic waste remaining in Surrey's residential garbage stream. Specific organic data found in reports should be presented as a percentage of net volume of the given daily sample.**

**Past garbage audit studies are not publically available. However more recent organic composition studies are available on the City's website at the following webpage: <http://www.surrey.ca/city-services/13015.aspx> under the "Composition Studies Update" heading. While these composition reports will provide a better understanding of what the City is seeking by way of data reporting, note that the level of detail found in these organic composition studies, regarding the breakdown of the organic waste, is not required for the purpose of this RFQ. Contractors should reference RFQ Schedule A - Section 2 - C. "Deliverables" for organic breakdown requirements.**
