INFORMATION FOR CONTRACTORS

The following information is provided to answer questions raised by Contractors for the above named project, to the extent referenced and shall become a part thereof. No consideration will be allowed for extras due to the contractor or any subcontractor not being familiar with this addendum. This Addendum No. 4 contains one (1) page in total:

Q1. Is this a unit price per tree for the year? Or unit price for each service?

A1. A Unit price for each tree for the year is appropriate. Typically, for invoicing purposes, we would then divide this unit price by 12 to arrive at a monthly rate per tree.

Q2. Horticultural Vinegars are not listed on your schedule A-5. I have made phone calls regarding the use of this product to control weeds and I have been told that it is acceptable to use for controlling weeds, according to the Surrey Bylaw ban on herbicides. Can you confirm that we will be able to use Horticultural Vinegars (such as Ecoclear) as a form of weed control.

A2. Acetic acid (vinegar) is a permitted pesticide, as per City of Surrey Bylaw No. 17160.

Q3. Is the application of Casoron an acceptable method of weed suppression in respect to this RFQ?

A3. Casoron is not a permitted pesticide, as per City of Surrey Bylaw No. 17160.
