INFORMATION FOR CONTRACTORS

Contractors are advised that Addendum No. 4 to RFQ 1220-040-2018-036 is hereby issued by the City. This addendum shall form part of the Contract Documents and is to be read, interpreted and coordinated with all other parts. The following information is provided to answer questions raised by Contractors for the above named project, to the extent referenced and shall become a part thereof. No consideration will be allowed for extras due to the Contractor or any sub-contractor not being familiar with this addendum. This Addendum No. 4 contains two (2) pages in total.

Q1: After having a quick look at the drawings, following are the items we require more clarifications on:-

“No separate specification file was issued with the drawings, but the drawings ask for the contractor to refer to specifications for items that need to be quantified (ex. demolition notes say spec will have complete list of items we must salvage for the owner) please provide the required information for all the notes in the drawing package that direct us to the specifications. “

A1: Specifications are included as "General Notes" on A1.1 and are to be read in accordance with drawings and other applicable contract documents as per note Division 1 - 1.11. As per Site Information notes and drawings (see for example A2.1), the existing security desk is being partly relocated/renovated for reuse.

The Owner may request to retain some spare parts (i.e.: desk lighting control).

Q2: Is pricing for the Data/Comm scope to be submitted as a sub-subcontractor through the Electrical Contractor? It appears as if there is only one approved Electrical Contractor (Houle Electric) and they self-perform Data/Comm work.

A2: There are no pre-approved Electrical Contractors, so bidding is open to all Electrical Contractors; however there are only four (4) Contractors pre-approved to perform the Data/Comm work. Data/Comm prices may be submitted under or as part of the Electrical Contractor pricing, or submitted separately to the General Contractors. The General Contractor is responsible for scope coverage and coordination.
