INFORMATION FOR CONTRACTORS

This Addendum is issued to provide additional information to the RFQ for the above named project, to the extent referenced and shall become a part thereof. No consideration will be allowed for extras due to the Contractor not being familiar with this Addendum. This Addendum No. 1 contains two (2) pages in total.

- Q1: All the trees are Red Alder. Is Red Alder considered to have commercial value? If so, what are the commercial specifications so we know how much debris we will be responsible to dispose of (for example – saw log specs?).
- A1: The City will inspect the trees and determine the construction grade trees once fallen.
- Q2: Are we able to do any chipping of tops and branches at the site of the tree removals?
- A2: Chipping and branch removal may be done on site, but all debris must be disposed of offsite.
- Q3: Where is the closest facility in Surrey that will accept wood waste?
- A3: Selection of a qualified disposal facility is the responsibility of the Contractor.
- Q4: What is the regulation regarding trees or any parts of trees falling into the Nicomekl & Serpentine Rivers?
- A4: It is the Contractor's responsibility to ensure no debris falls in the rivers.

Q5: Once salvageable timber is assessed and marked is the Contractor to pile it for transportation provided by the City and where is the timber to be piled as there is limited space along the access?

A5: It will be the Contractor's responsibility to transport the salvageable timber. Stockpile space is available at the road allowances of 152nd Street for Site 1 and 160th Street for Site 2.

Q6: Will the Dyke be mowed and cut before work is expected to take place?

A6: No.

Q7: Is access from service roads available, can we access all private farm roads with equipment?

A7: The only access the City is providing is along the Dyke right of way.
