INFORMATION FOR PROPONENTS

This Request for Proposals (RFP) addendum shall form part of the RFP documents and is to be read, interpreted and coordinated with all other parts. The cost of all work herein shall be included in the contract sum. The following revisions supersede the information contained in the original instructions and specifications issued for the above named project.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

Q1: Will the team of engineers that put together the indicative design, functional program and perhaps a schematic design for the City continue to be involved in the project?

A1: The City engaged two separate engineering firms to provide technical advisory services during two separate phases of the Biofuel Facility project (Project):

Phase 1 – Business Case

- The City engaged with Engineering Consultant to provide indicative design and costing (capital and operation) for a 80,000 tonne per year anaerobic digestion facility. This information was used within a business case that was included in the City's application to the PPP Canada Fund.
- The services concluded once the City received approval for the PPP Canada funding.

Phase 2 – PPP Procurement Process

- The City engaged with Engineering Consultant to provide technical advisory services during the Project procurement process (Request for Qualifications and Request for Proposals).
- The services will conclude if/when the City reaches financial close on the Project.

Q2: Will the DB team use the indicative design as reference materials?

A2: Proponents to the Project have not been provided any of the City's indicative designs. The Project is being delivered as a traditional Private-Public-Partnership (PPP). Under this model, the City will select a single partner that will be responsible to design, build, finance,

maintain and operate (DBFO) the entire facility for a 25-year contract term. To this end, Proponents to the Project will submit independent proposals incorporating all components of the DBFO.
