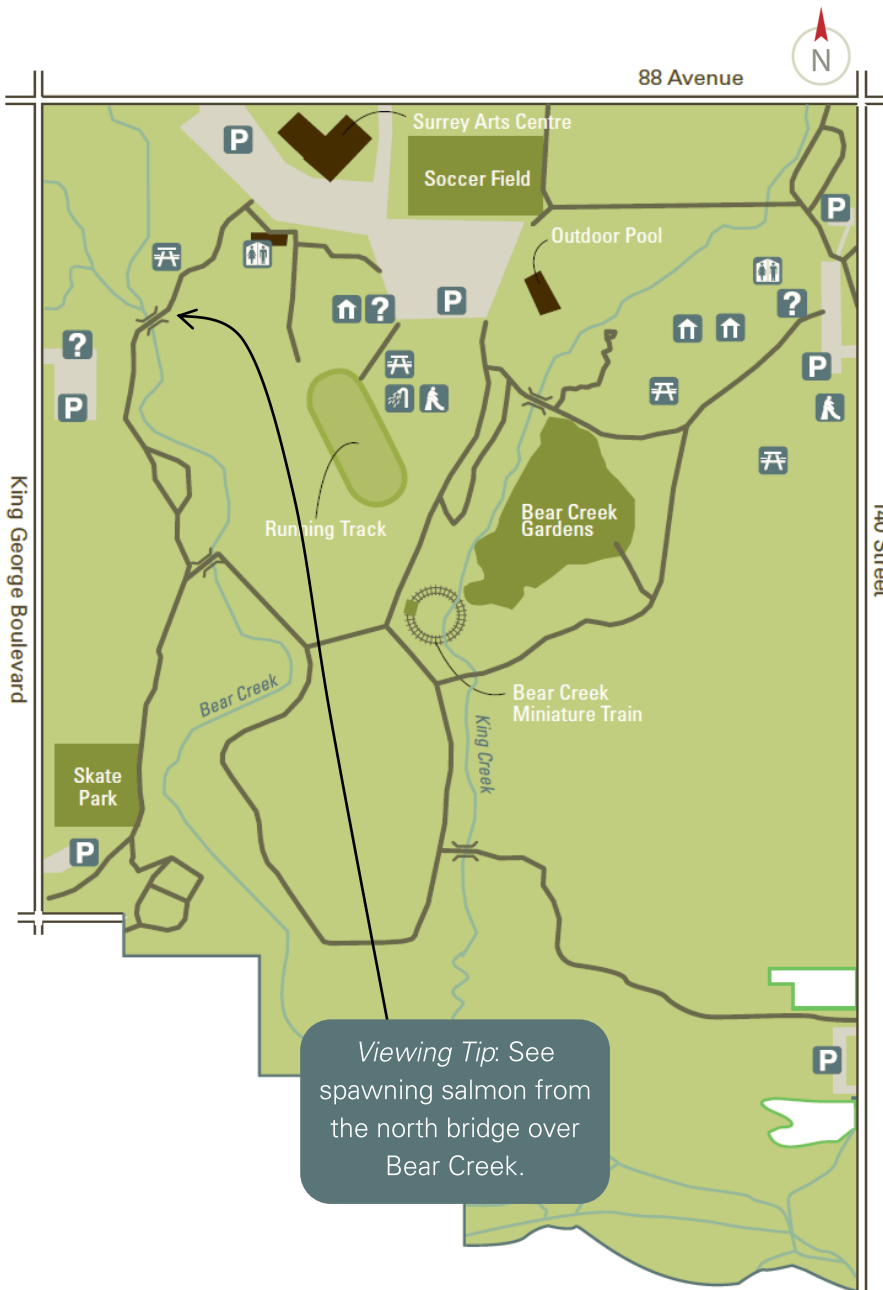

Bear Creek Park

PARK LOCATION: 13750 - 88 AVE

One of Surrey's most popular parks, Bear Creek Park offers a combination of quiet walks and outdoor activities that make it an ideal spot for family adventures or individual exploring.

This park is home to two salmon-bearing streams: Bear Creek and King Creek. If you visit between October and mid-November you might see chum, coho and chinook salmon returning to their spawning grounds.

 Keep dogs on leash at all times; please clean up after your dog.

 Leave all plants and animals for others to enjoy. Do not feed birds and wildlife.
