



Historic Stewart Farm Boy Scouts of Canada Badge Program Black Star Badge

This program meets all 7 requirements of the ***Black Star*** badge.

- Develop wild bird knowledge while making a bird house from recycled materials.
- Create a sample bird observation booklet to keep a record of birds through the seasons. Discuss which bird species are protected in the Lower Mainland and British Columbia.
- Go on a guided nature walk through surrounding Elgin Heritage Park. Collect samples of natural items found in the surrounding area to take home, mount and display.
- Visit the Farm's Bee Garden to learn how bees and flowers rely on each other to get food and to reproduce.
- Check out the Root Cellar to explore common tools and find out how to use and care for them. Try them out in barrel planters, and plant a seed to take home.
