# ***HOMEOWNER PLUMBING INSTALLATIONS***

Property owners wishing to install plumbing in their own place of residence must provide a drawing and/or sketch showing the proposed layout with their application for Plumbing Permit.

The purpose of this sketch is to enable the Plumbing Inspector to check the intended installation so that correction may be made before the plumbing is installed. Having a drawing checked by the Inspector first will help the homeowner in doing the installation correctly and also alleviate additional inspections being made by the Municipal Inspector.

This requirement is in compliance with Surrey By-law No. 6569 and the 1998 B.C. Plumbing Code.
