Project IRIS is a voluntary camera registry that records the location of businesses and residents security cameras in Surrey. This registry is a partnership between the City of Surrey, Surrey RCMP, businesses and the community. It is part of the City of Surrey's Public Safety Strategy.

Often evidence needed to solve a crime can be recorded by a nearby camera. If an incident occurs, RCMP will contact City of Surrey staff to get a list of nearby camera locations. RCMP officers will then contact the registered camera owners to request access to recorded video footage. Your footage could help gather evidence for an investigation.

Registering cameras located at your home or business is completely voluntary and you can have your information removed from the registry at any time by contacting [cctvregistry@surrey.ca](mailto:cctvregistry@surrey.ca). Residents and businesses can register multiple camera locations. Joining the camera registry does not mean you are obligated to share your footage; it simply records the location of your camera.

If you or your business have a camera that is able to record footage on your property then you could help RCMP gather evidence in the event of an incident in your community.
