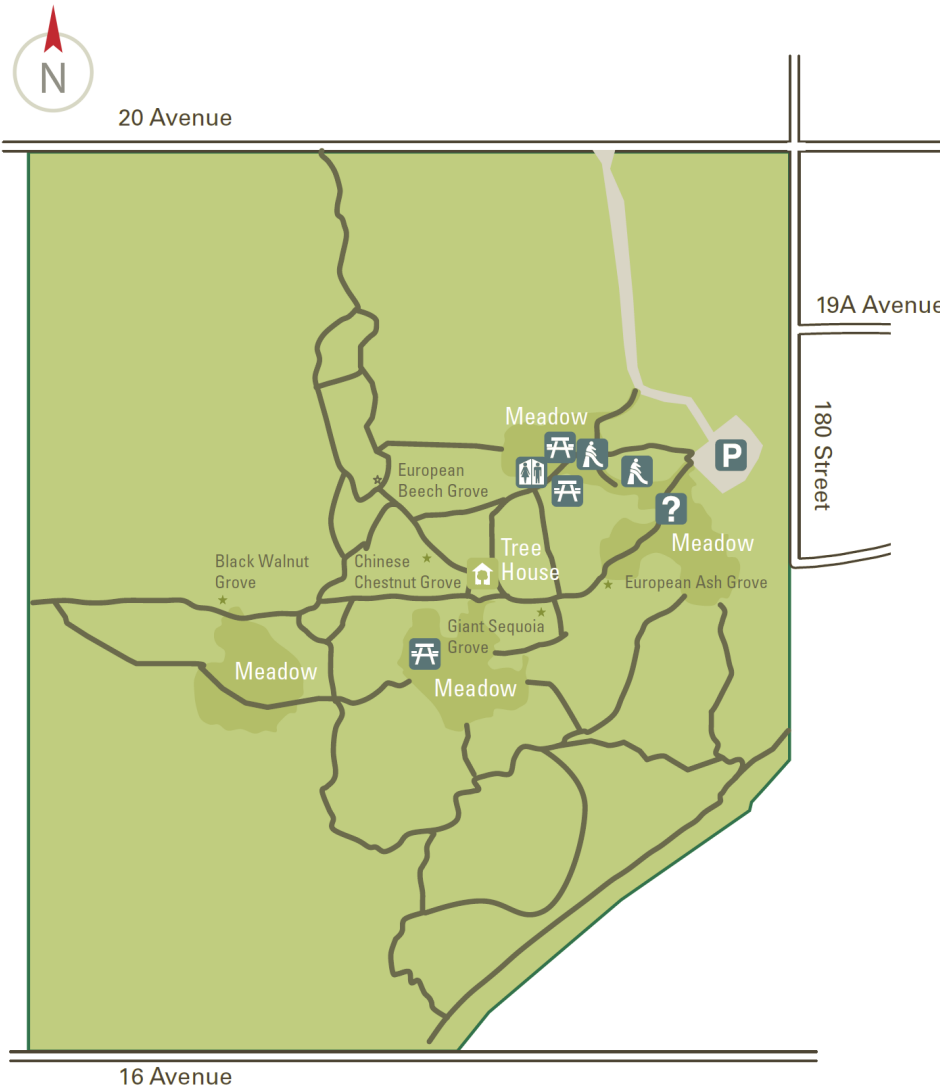

This park has 50 different species of trees and five towering groves for you to discover. This arboretum was started by twin brothers, David and Peter Brown, back in 1893.

The trails wind through forest, meadows, and five spectacular groves of trees including the park's namesake - a Redwood grove. The trees here are ever-changing with the seasons, so make sure to visit year-round and watch as the green turns to gold and then back again. If you are looking for more rugged trails, try the southern portion of the park.
