The Rig Dig Program

The Rig Dig Program is managed by the Lookout Emergency Aid Society in Surrey and runs 7 days a week across Surrey North & Whalley. Crews collect and safely dispose of needles and syringes at sites during morning (8:00am – 12:00pm) and afternoon (1:00pm – 4:00pm) shifts each day. Rig Dig uses employees, as well as trained volunteers, to assist in collecting needles and syringes.



The Mobile Harm Reduction Team

The Mobile Harm Reduction Team is also run by the Lookout Emergency Aid Society and provides supplies and education to people who use substances and community organizations.
