

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 10814

A by-law to authorize the dedication of land owned by the Corporation of the District of Surrey for use as a public highway.

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WHEREAS the land hereinafter described is required for use as a public highway;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following land, all in the Municipality of Surrey, Province of British Columbia:

All that portion of the east Two Hundred Eight (208) Feet of Lot Twenty-Nine (29), Section Twenty-Six (26), Block Five (5) North, Range Two (2) West, Plan Five Thousand Two Hundred Ten (5210), New Westminster District, shown outlined in heavy black line on Reference Plan attached hereto, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by Peter M. Mueller, B.C.L.S. on January 14, 1991, and containing Three Hundred Seventy-Nine (379.0) Square Metres

(Portion of 13931 - 100 Avenue).

at or for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) plus tax adjustment and conveyancing costs, is hereby declared to be set aside and used for Corporation of the District of Surrey as a public highway only.

2. A reference plan will accompany this By-law for registration purposes outlining the above property in black, and duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk.

3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "100 Avenue/139 Street Highway Dedication By-law, 1991, No. 10814."

PASSED THREE READINGS by the Municipal Council on the 28th day of January, 1991.
