SUBJECT: Award of Contract No. 1220-030-2021-046

Cloverdale Sport & Ice Complex: Electrical, Mechanical,

Ice Plant Refrigeration, and Elevator

#### RECOMMENDATION

The Planning & Development Department and the Director, Strategic Initiatives & Corporate Reporting recommend that Council:

- 1. Award Contract No. 1220-030-2021-046 to Graham Construction and Engineering LP in the amount of \$16,880,345.80 (including GST) for the electrical, mechanical, ice plant refrigeration, and elevator related to the new Cloverdale Sport & Ice Complex;
- 2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for Contract No. 1220-030-2021-046 for the electrical, mechanical, ice plant refrigeration, and elevator at \$20,000,000.00 (including GST and contingency); and
- 3. Authorize the General Manager, Planning & Development to execute Contract No. 1220-030-2021-046.

#### **INTENT**

The intent of this report is to seek Council approval to award a contract for the electrical, mechanical, ice plant refrigeration, and elevator for the Cloverdale Sport & Ice Complex development project (the "Project").

#### **BACKGROUND**

To date, Council has awarded three contracts to Graham Construction and Engineering LP ("Graham") in the amount of \$25,644,085.09 (including GST) for the construction of early works, the pre-engineered metal building structure, the supply and installation of piles foundation, and for the civil, formwork, reinforcement steel, and concrete supply.

#### **DISCUSSION**

Graham's performance on the work awarded to date has been satisfactory, and it is now recommended that the contract with Graham be extended to include electrical, mechanical, ice plant refrigeration, and elevator for the Project.

#### **Tender and Quotation Process**

Phased pre-qualification processes were issued by Graham to prequalify trade contractors for the Project's main works. The work of each trade is being tendered separately with the intention of selecting the lowest quote for each element of the work and combining them under one general contract that would then be assigned to Graham as the general contractor for construction of the Project.

A list of the trade contractors who submitted a quotation for the subject works of the Project is attached as Appendix "I", along with the respective price that they submitted. In each case, the bidder providing the lowest quotation that fully meets the specifications of the related work is being awarded that element of work. The contract amount of \$16,880,345.80 (including GST) is recommended to be awarded to Graham.

#### **Project Schedule**

Construction of the Project commenced in August 2022. Following the work of this contract, staff are working with Graham to obtain quotations for the remaining works.

Ongoing supply chain issues have the potential to negatively impact the Project. Staff are working with Graham to address these issues so that the Project will be ready for use, as originally intended, in September 2024.

### **Next Steps**

As part of the 2023 Five-Year (2023-2027) Financial Plan – Capital Program, the Project was increased from two National Hockey League sized arena sheets to three National Hockey League sized arena sheets. Staff are working with the design team to amend the Project to include the third sheet. Staff will be bringing forward a Corporate Report to Council for their consideration to authorize an increase to the design and construction administration services in June. As part of this report, staff will also provide a schedule for the construction and completion of the third sheet.

#### **FUNDING**

Funding for this Contract is available within the approved 2023 Five-Year (2023-2027) Financial Plan – Capital Program.
