SUBJECT: Award of Contract No. 1220-020-2024-002

District Energy Transfer Stations

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

- 1. Award Contract No. 1220-020-2024-002 to All-Pro Services in the amount of \$2,842,119.00 (including GST) for construction of 12 District Energy Transfer Stations;
- 2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for Contract No. 1220-020-2024-002 at \$3,126,500.00 (including contingencies and GST); and
- 3. Authorize the General Manager, Engineering to execute Contract No. 1220-020-2024-002

INTENT

The intent of this report is to seek Council's approval to award an agreement for contractor services to supply, install, and commission district energy transfer stations and interior piping for twelve new buildings in City Centre.

DISCUSSION

Scope of Work

The construction package related to this contract consists of the supply, installation and commissioning of mechanical and electrical equipment for 12 energy transfer stations ("ETS") and their interior piping design which are located in customer buildings and transfer thermal energy from the City's district energy piping to the building. The work will be conducted at the locations listed in the following table, which are also illustrated on the map attached to this report as Appendix "I":

Invitation to Tender Results

An Invitation to Tender followed the City's Purchasing Bylaw and was publicly posted on the BC Bid and City of Surrey websites. Tenders for the subject contract were received and opened on January 25, 2024, with the following results:

The Engineer's (FVB Energy Inc.) pre-tender estimate was \$3.5M (including GST).

Evaluation

The submissions were reviewed for accuracy and completeness. No errors were found. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond and were signed on the Tender Form.

The low bidder, All-Pro Services., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and has agreed to complete the work between February 19th, 2024 and July 1, 2025 as stipulated in the contract. All-Pro Services' past performance on similar work has been satisfactory. They have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that All-Pro Services be awarded Contract No. 1220-020-2024-002.

Project Schedule

The contract work is expected to start in February 2024 and be completed by July 2025.


Funding for this contract is available in the approved 2024 District Energy Budget.
