SUBJECT: Report of 1999 Council Remuneration and Expense Payments

## **RECOMMENDATION**

1. That Council receives the attached information (Appendices A to L) listing remuneration and expenses for Council members for 1999.
2. That a copy of the information be made available for public inspection at the office of the City Clerk for one year.

## **BACKGROUND**

Section 329.1 of the Municipal Act requires that at least once a year Council must have prepared a separate report, listing each Council member by name with the following information:

- (a) The total amount of remuneration paid to the Councillor for discharge of the duties of office, including any amount specified as an expense allowance.
- (b) The total amount of expense payments for the Councillor when representing the City, engaging in City business,

or attending a meeting, course or convention.

(c) The total amount of any benefits including insurance policies and policies for medical or dental services provided to the Councillor or Councillor's dependants.

Section 329 requires that this report must be considered by Council at a Council meeting, open to the public, and a copy of the report must be available for public inspection at the City Hall during its regular office hours from the date when it is considered until one year thereafter.

## **CONCLUSION**

The Municipal Act requires only the total amount of remuneration and the total amount of expenses to be listed for each Council member. The information attached as Appendices A to L provides more detailed information that might otherwise be requested under the Freedom of Information Act.
