## RECOMMENDATION

That Council pass a resolution requesting the Minister of Municipal Affairs issue an order pursuant to Section 248 of the Local Government Act for authorization to write off the property taxes levied on three properties dedicated to road use since 1997.

## BACKGROUND

Al's Auto Wrecking Ltd. owned three properties which were subdivided in 1997. The residual properties from the subdivision were granted new roll numbers and property taxes were levied accordingly. Three properties resulting from the subdivision were dedicated for road use and in accordance with Section 339 of the Local Government Act taxes on these properties should never have been levied.

## CURRENT

The three properties have balances in our tax accounts which will never be paid. To clean up the City's information systems and streamline processing, we request write off of outstanding property taxes on the road use properties.
