SUBJECT: Contract Award M.S. 4898-420-11, Westport Construction Group Inc.

RECOMMENDATION

That Contract M.S. 4898-420-11 be awarded to the low bidder, Westport Construction Group Inc., in the amount of \$1,477,991.00 including GST.

SCOPE OF WORK

Contract M.S. 4898-420-11 involves the construction of a 2 cubic metre per second capacity pump station / flood box structure by the Serpentine River at 176 Street. This pump station will minimize the frequency and duration of flooding experienced by the areas north of Fry's Corner (176 Street and Fraser Highway). This pump station is a key component of the Serpentine-Nicomekl flood control project. The objective is to provide ARDSA level of service to the Fry's Corner North Functional Area.

Construction is expected to start by May 7, 2001, and be completed by November 15, 2001.
