**SUBJECT: Contract Award - M.S. 1701-001 Aggressive Roadbuilders Ltd.**

## **RECOMMENDATION**

That Contract M.S. 1701-001 be awarded to the low bidder, Aggressive Roadbuilders Ltd., in the amount of \$1,428,943.27, including GST.

## **SCOPE OF WORK**

The scope of work under this contract includes intersection improvements, traffic signals, sidewalks and preloading at the following locations:

- 80 Avenue at 132 Street
- 88 Avenue at 168 Street
- 88 Avenue at 176 Street
- 176 Street: 6000 Block – 64 Avenue

Construction is expected to start July 30, 2001, and be completed by November 23, 2001.

## **TENDER RESULTS**

Tenders for Contract M.S. 1701-007 were received on June 14, 2001, with the results as follows:

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$1,458,000 including GST.

## EVALUATION

All tenders were reviewed by our consultant. They found several minor arithmetical errors which did not affect the low bidder's price or the order of the other tenderers. All the tenderers submitted the required 10% bid bond and signed and sealed the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, Aggressive Roadbuilders Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work in 80 days as stipulated in the contract. Aggressive Roadbuilders Ltd., and their sub-contractors, have satisfactorily completed many similar projects for the City in the past and we have found them to be acceptable.
