RECOMMENDATION

That Council authorize the City Clerk to bring forward for three readings, the new "City Heritage Sites Financial Assistance By-law" (Appendix "A") for three readings.

INTENT

The intent of the new by-law is to replace "Municipal Heritage Sites Financial Compensation By-law, 1983, No. 7692" which was inadvertently repealed by an amending by-law, and introduce a new by-law in accordance with the "Local Government Act"

DISCUSSISON

"Municipal Heritage Sites Financial Compensation By-law, 1983, No. 7692" was inadvertently repealed by an amending by-law in 1991. The new by-law will provide for heritage preservation and maintenance grants for designated heritage features or heritage properties, and the "Local Government Act" requires that any expenditures for this purpose receive a 2/3 majority vote of Council. Any expenditures under this by-law recommended to Council will note that a 2/3 majority vote is required.
