## RECOMMENDATION

That the construction contract for the Surrey Museum be awarded to Dominion Fairmile Construction Ltd. the low bidder for a total amount of \$4,530,500.00 excluding GST.

## BACKGROUND

The Surrey Museum is a brand new facility that will be located on Highway #10 near 176A Street in Cloverdale. This is a ranked capital project by Council and is partly funded through the Infrastructure Program. Four bids were received and Dominion Fairmile Construction Ltd. was the lowest bid. The bids received were as follows:

Dominion Fairmile Construction Ltd.	\$4,530,500.00
D.G.S. Construction Company Ltd.	\$4,567,500 00
West Pro Constructors	\$4,568,074.70
Titan Construction	\$4,595,614.30

All bids were reviewed for errors and were found to be correct. The proposed construction is \$3.9 million. An additional \$600,000 will be requested from Council in a separate report.

## CONCLUSION

It is recommended to award the construction contract for the Surrey Museum be awarded to the low bidder, Dominion Fairmile Construction Ltd., for a total amount of \$4,530,500.00 excluding GST.
