

64 AVENUE WIDENING PROJECT

184 St. - Fraser Hwy.

Improving travel through the area and between communities whether you drive, take transit, cycle or walk.

A better 64 Avenue:

- Construction of 4 lanes for present and future traffic volumes, with no provision for on-street parking
- Construction of raised landscaped medians and left turn bays to improve road safety
- Installation of grade-separated one-way cycle tracks on both sides, increasing rider safety and comfort
- Extension of sidewalks on at least one side of 64 Avenue and, addition of new 188 Street sidewalk on east side between 60 and 64 Avenues, for better pedestrian movement
- Added right-in, right-out and/or left-in movements at 184 and 187 Street intersections, improving access and circulation for local neighbourhoods
- Safety and traffic flow improvements at 64 Avenue/186 Street and 64 Avenue/190 Street intersections:
- New pedestrian signals

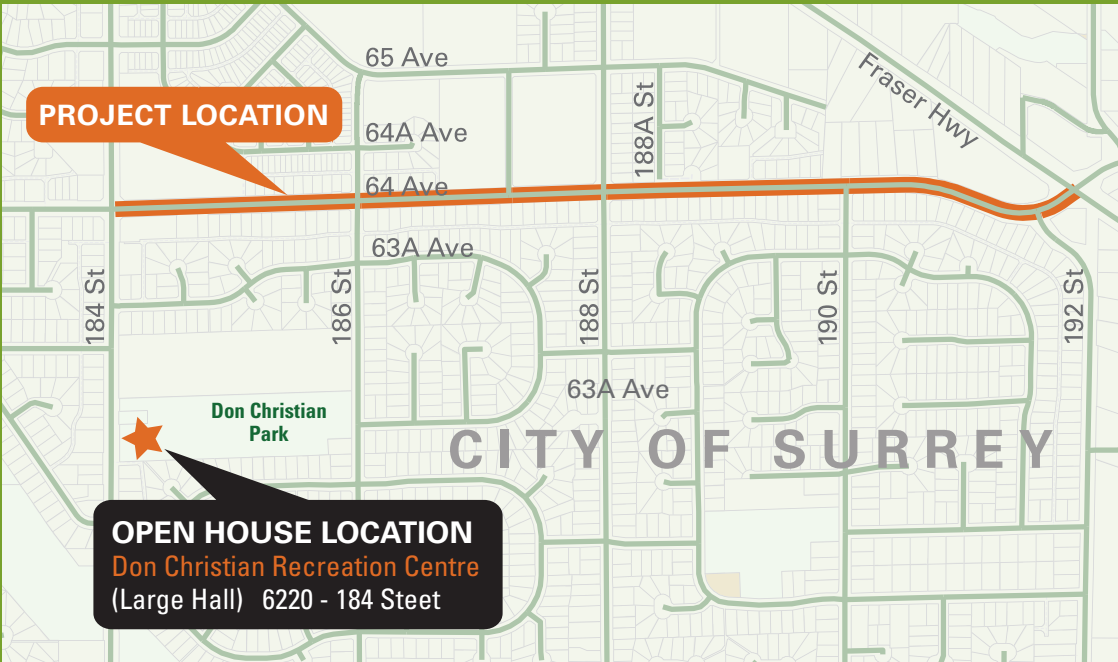
Project Overview

The City is planning to widen 64 Avenue, between 184 Street and Fraser Highway, to two lanes in each direction with additional improvements for pedestrians, cyclists and transit users. Upgrading this important east-west link supports trip safety and reliability no matter how you choose to get around.

- Dual left-turn lanes eastbound and westbound directions on 64 Ave
- Enhanced street and pedestrian lighting, street trees and upgraded transit stops
- Finished road with curb, gutters and new pavement

Why 64 Avenue?

64 Avenue services the Cloverdale and East Clayton areas of Surrey and serves as an important east-west connector from Highway 15/176 Street to Fraser Highway. Ultimately, the City intends to deliver a multi-phase program of widening and providing multimodal infrastructure along the entire 64 Avenue corridor from 120 Street (Delta border) through Newton and the Cloverdale area (Surrey) to 196 Street Township of Langley border). As part of TransLink's Major Road Network, 64 Avenue is a key link between the three communities.
