The theme of this exhibition is *Kalayaan* (Freedom) and pays tribute to the freedom that the Filipino people enjoy today.

Led by Dimasalang founder and leader Sofronio Ylanan Mendoza, better known by his initials SYM, member artists showcase a variety of artistic styles with a focus on recent works. The Dimasalang group was formed in 1968 in Manila. The word “Dimasalang” originated from Philippine national hero and freedom fighter, Dr. Jose Rizal, a revolutionary writer who used “Dimasalang” as his pseudonym during the turn of the 19th century when the Philippines was under Spanish rule. It was Jose Rizal’s writings and martyrdom that sparked a fervent call for freedom. The group’s name ‘Dimasalang’ was adopted after the street in Manila where the founding artist SYM lived at the time.
