## Local goes global with new digital art project...

The GLOCAL project will use digital cameras and motion-capture technology, to reflect the speed, size, density and diversity that positions Surrey in local and global (Glocal) consciousness. Surrey in motion will then be connected to other communities in motion, around the world.

All the content produced as part of the GLOCAL project will form a large relational artwork; an interactive database of 'moving' images. The project begins in Surrey, with a series of outreach initiatives to youth and community interest groups, as well as online communities through its website. The invitation for involvement will be repeated internationally through community workshops held in various locations. When realized, audiences will be able to compare, contrast and examine the world from all points of the globe.

So how can YOU become part of GLOCAL and express what's cool where you live? The GLOCAL team of artists have now established residence both online and at the Surrey Art Gallery TechLab. Currently they are producing low-tech toolkits – guides with instructions, open source software and ideas, intended to guide participants on how to contribute to the project.
