The results of this survey, conducted between November 7, 2019 and December 4, 2019 are not weighted to the City of Surrey's population.

The results are based on 543 survey responses.

# Background

The City of Surrey has started on a two-year process to create a community plan for Fleetwood to guide where people, paths, parks, roads and buildings will go and to plan for the extension of SkyTrain along Fraser Highway.

This survey was designed to gather input from residents on their vision for the future of Fleetwood. Survey participants were invited to share their ideas on how Fleetwood can grow with transit and accommodate new housing, jobs, and community spaces.




Open Community Survey: 382 responses from November 7 – December 4, 2019

## Relationship with Fleetwood



# Accommodating a Growing Population



# Improving Transportation Network







This heat map visually displays which areas of the image were highlighted by participants. A darker colored area indicates that more participants highlighted it.





Total: 489 participants







# Preferred Locations for Future Events


