

Storm Drain Marking Challenge Contest Rules and Regulations

1) ENTRY PERIOD: You will be automatically entered for the giveaway when you register for the Storm Drain Marking Challenge during the 2021 Storm Drain Marking Challenge. Registration is now open and the Contest ends August 15th, 2021 at 11:59 pm.

2) ELIGIBILITY: You must be thirteen (13) years or older to enter this Contest. You must also be a legal resident of Surrey. If you are under nineteen (19) years of age you must receive the consent of your parent or guardian to claim a prize. City of Surrey employees and immediate family members of City of Surrey employees are not eligible to enter.

3) HOW TO ENTER AND GUIDELINES: Every household who has registered to participate in the Storm Drain Marking Challenge will be automatically entered to win a prize. There is a limited of one (1) entry per household. Late or corrupt entries will not be accepted.
