

**Surrey Transportation Plan Virtual Open House Contest
Official Rules & Regulations**

1) ENTRY PERIOD: The Contest begins at **6 am Pacific Time Tuesday October 13, 2020** and ends at **11:59pm Pacific Time Friday November 27, 2020**.

2) ELIGIBILITY: You must be thirteen (13) years or older and a legal resident in the province of British Columbia (BC) to enter this Contest. If you are under nineteen (19) years of age you must receive the consent of your parent or guardian to claim a prize. Employees and immediate family members of City of Surrey employees are not eligible to enter.

3) HOW TO ENTER: Between **6 am Pacific Time Tuesday October 13, 2020** and **11:59pm Pacific Time Monday November 27, 2020** visit the **Surrey Transportation Plan Virtual Open House Registration Page** and opt-in to the contest by selecting yes to enter prize draw. You may enter a maximum of one (1) time: one (1) entry for fully completing the form. This Contest is in no way sponsored, administered, or associated with Facebook, Inc., Twitter, Inc., or Instagram, Inc. By entering, entrants confirm that they are 13+ years of age, release Facebook, Twitter & Instagram of responsibility, and agree to Facebook, Instagram and Twitter's terms of use.

4) ENTRY GUIDELINES: The registration form must be completed in full. Previously published material for which non-exclusive rights were granted may be entered as long as you still maintain the right to grant us a license. Entries must be in English. Late or corrupt entries will not be accepted. Your entries must not be obscene or otherwise inappropriate, as determined by the City of Surrey in its sole discretion. Entries that are deemed inappropriate will not be accepted. You are responsible for obtaining, prior to submitting any entry, any releases and consents necessary to permit the exhibition and use of the entry in the manner described in these Official Rules without additional compensation. If any person appearing in any photo is under the age of majority in their province of residence the signature of a parent or legal guardian is required on each release.
