


Welcome back to


I will need to register online or by phone for a time to come and work out. I will not be able to register in person. The times that are free might be different than what I am used to. That's ok.

I need to stay home if I feel sick and I will not be allowed into a centre if I am sick.

We're in this together and I can adapt to the changes.
