Francis Baptiste is an Indigenous songwriter and music journalist from the Osoyoos Indian Band. His debut LP, *Snəqsilx^w* (Family), features songs sung in Nsyilxcən [nah-silk-sen], the endangered language of the Syilx [see-ilks] people. Approximately 50 elders can fluently speak Nsyilxcən. For Baptiste, his journey in learning the language and teaching it to his son begins with this album. *Family (Snəqsilx^w)* is his effort to preserve and connect with this vital part of his heritage.
