

ADVANCE ELECTOR REGISTRATION LIST OF REGISTERED ELECTORS

Are you eligible to vote in the municipal election for Mayor, Councillor and School Trustee?

Is your name on the current list of electors?

If you are not sure, you can find out by visiting the City of Surrey's website at surrey.ca/election.

The close of advance registration for the municipal election in the City of Surrey is **August 23, 2022 at 4:30pm.**

Advance elector registrations will be accepted at the City of Surrey, Legislative Services Department until August 23, 2022 at 4:30pm. Elector registrations will not be accepted during the period between August 24, 2022 and October 15, 2022, but will be accepted on voting days at the voting location.

ELECTOR QUALIFICATIONS

RESIDENT ELECTORS:

- 18 years of age or older; and
- a Canadian citizen; and
- a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration; and
- a resident of the City of Surrey, or as applicable, within Election Area 1 of School District No. 36 (Surrey); and
- not disqualified from voting in an election and not otherwise disqualified by law.

NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTORS:

- 18 years of age or older; and
- a Canadian citizen; and
- a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration; and
- a registered owner of real property in the City of Surrey or, as applicable, within Election Area 1 of School District No. 36 (Surrey) for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration; and
- the only persons who are registered owners of the property, either as joint tenants or tenants in common, are individuals who are not holding the property in trust for a corporation or another trust; and
- not entitled to register as a resident elector; and
- not disqualified from voting in an election and not otherwise disqualified by law; and
- if there is more than one registered owner of the property, only one of those individuals may, with the written consent of the majority of the owners, register as a non-resident property elector.

LIST OF REGISTERED ELECTORS

Beginning August 24, 2022 until the close of general voting for the election on October 15, 2022, a copy of the list of registered electors will be available for public inspection, at Surrey City Hall, Legislative Services Department, 13450 - 104 Avenue, Surrey, BC, between 8:30am and 4:30pm, Monday to Friday, excluding statutory holidays.

Before inspecting the list, a person must sign a statement that they will not make copies, or use the information included in the list except for the purposes of Part 3 – Electors and Elections of the *Local Government Act*.

REQUEST TO OMIT OR OBSCURE

An elector may request that their address or other personal information about them be omitted from or obscured on the list of electors. The elector must contact the Deputy Chief Election Officer to make this request at dceo@surrey.ca.

OBJECTION TO REGISTRATION OF AN ELECTOR

An objection to the registration of a person whose name appears on the list of registered electors may be made in accordance with the *Local Government Act* until 4:00pm on September 9, 2022. An objection must be in writing and an objection may only be made by a person entitled to be registered as an elector of the City of Surrey or, as applicable, Election Area 1 of School District No. 36 (Surrey) and only on the basis that a person whose name appears on the list of electors has died or is not qualified to register as an elector of the City of Surrey.
